RULES AND REGULATION OF THE EVENTS

REGISTRATION

- 1 The Application form for participation in the Convention is enclosed herewith. It is also available in the website of Galaxy Public School at www.galaxy.edu.np
- 2 The last date for registration is Friday, October 30, 2009.
- 3 Registration Fee: RS. 250 per participant.
- 4 Registration Fee for two teachers accompanying each participating team is waived.
- 5 Registration & reporting time is from 12:00-14:00 hrs at Nepal Academy Hall (*Nepal Pragya Pratisthan*), Kamaladi.

The Application form should be accompanied by the participation fee of Rs. 250 per participant.

1 CASE STUDY PRESENTATION

- Case study presentation is open for students of all level.
- Each team is allotted a time slot of 15 minutes and the participants are requested to restrict themselves to the time schedule.
- **This time includes the following activities**
 - a Setting up of the stage
 - b Introduction of circle members
 - c Case Study Presentation
 - d Concluding remarks by the commentators
 - e Questions from the floor and feedbacks by judges.
 - f Presentation of souvenir to the team by the Event organizer.
 - g Photo session
- In lieu of the above, the teams are advised to plan their presentation within 15 minutes and all teams are requested to cooperate with the organizer to adhere to the time schedule.
- A warning bell will be rung after 13 minutes and then the final bell will be rung after 15 minutes indicating the end of the presentation.
- Upon ringing of the warning bell, the team should immediately round off the presentation.
- The number of participants in the Case Study Presentation should be 4-10.
- One soft copy or e-copy of the case study prepared must be submitted in CD to the Convention Coordination office on **Friday, October 30, 2009.**

Note Case Study Presentation is the major event of any SQC Convention. To be a part of this convention, a school must participate in Case Study Presentation.

2 SPEECH CONTEST

This event aims to provide girl students with a platform where they can voice their ideas and concerns on the topic.

- Each school will be represented by 1 girl student.
- The participants will be seated together and the host of the programme will call upon the participants on to the stage to deliver their views and ideas.
- Each participant will be given a topic on the theme "Role of SQC in women empowerment" 30 minutes before the commencement of the event.
- Time allotted for each speaker is 4 minutes. After 3 minutes a warning bell will be rung and then the speech must be concluded by the next minute.

3 ENGLISH SPELLING CONTEST

- Each school can send 2 participants for spelling contest.
- Participants of all the schools will be placed together and a word will be asked to each participant. If the word is spelt correctly the participant remains on the stage or else s/he will have to leave the stage.
- The process continues until the last participant remains on stage and thus s/he will be adjudged the winner.
- The list of words will be provided 1 day before the spelling contest.
- The first meaning, usage, and part of speech for the word given in the dictionary will only be considered for use during the contest.
- A time limit of 45 seconds is allotted for spelling each word asked. If the meaning and usage is asked for the time will not be paused and the given 45 seconds are all a team has.
- The Oxford Advanced Dictionary (7th edition) is the official dictionary for the contest. This dictionary has to be brought by the participant themselves.

4 POSTER AND SLOGAN CONTEST

- Each school can send one team represented by 2 participants.
- Topic shall be given on the spot around convention theme.
- The participants shall work collectively to present an attractive poster with a slogan on the given Topic.
- The time allotted is 2 hours.
- Participants must bring their own poster colours and brushes and other materials needed.
- At the venue, the organizer will provide white card sheets 22"x28". Arrangements will be made for display of the posters.
- The poster will be evaluated on the basis of creativity, neatness, originality and interpretation of the Theme.
- After the display, posters shall be retained by the organizers.

5 TRADITIONAL NEPALESE INSTRUMENTS CONTEST

- Each team can choose any 5 instruments from the list provided below: Sarangi, Madal, Bansuri, Harmonium, Jhyaali, Damphu, Dhime, Tungna, Murchunga and Sahanai.
- Each team will be represented by 5 students.
- Each team will present a self composed traditional Nepali musical composition of not more than 8 minutes.
- The composition can either be lyrics based or melody based.
- Participants, themselves, are responsible for making the necessary arrangements for the required instruments.
- Marks will be awarded for presentation, composition, melody and rhythm.
- Lyrics will not be entertained for the compositions.

6 STORY FORMING CONTEST

- Each school can send 3 participants for story forming contest.
- A few objects or materials will be placed before these students.
- The students will be asked to relate the different objects or materials with each other and form a story within 45 minutes.
- The word limit for the story is 300 words.
- The 10 best stories will be chosen by a panel of judges for the final round. The chosen teams get 6 minutes to present the story before the judges. The participating students will read out the story.
- Points will be awarded on the basis of expression, language, content and creativity.

7 COLLAGE CONTEST

- Topic or Theme shall be given on the spot.
- Each team will be represented by 2 participants.
- The participants shall work collectively to present a collage to project the given Topic or Theme.
- The time allotted for the contest is 2 hours.
- A definite set of materials will be provided by the organizers to the participating teams and the collage must be created from the materials provided.
- At the venue, the organizer will provide white card sheets 22"x28" or trays. Arrangements will be made for display of these collages.
- The collage will be judged on the basis of creativity, neatness, originality and interpretation of the Theme.
